 - n. Assistant Secretary for Congressional and Intergovernmental Affairs
 - o. Assistant Secretary for Environment, Safety and Health
 - p. Assistant Secretary for Fossil Energy

- q. Assistant Secretary for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy
- r. Director, National Nuclear Security Administration Service Center
- s. Manager, Savannah River Operations Office
- t. Manager, Oak Ridge Office
- 4. <u>NO INDIVIDUAL</u> serving in an acting capacity in any of the positions described above is included in this Succession Order.
- 5. <u>ANY OFFICIAL</u> serving as acting Secretary pursuant to this Succession Order, during the period of service as acting Secretary under this Order, may exercise all authority vested by law in the Secretary.
