DIRECTIVES EXEMPTION APPROVAL MEMORANDUM

PURPOSE: To document BPA's exemption from DOE Order 460.2A, *Materials Transportation and Packaging Management*.

BACKGROUND: This Order establishes requirements and responsibilities for management of DOE materials transportation and packaging.

JUSTIFICATION: BPA operations are not involved with any activities associated with the packaging and transportation of off-site shipments, onsite shipments, or transfers of radioactive or explosive materials. BPA does not have Site/Facility Management Contractors.

The Objective, 1.b., is to ensure the safe, secure, efficient packaging and transportation of materials both hazardous and nonhazardous. BPA meets this objective by continuing to adhere to the packaging and transportation safety requirements defined by the Department of Transportation for hazardous materials, Title 49 CFR, Parts 100 – 173 regulations. Bonneville's

hazardous materials transportation and training needs are accomplished fully through the application of and compliance with Title 49 CFR.

RECOMMENDATION: Recommend that you approve this exemption document.
