DIRECTIVES EQUIVALENCY APPROVAL MEMORANDUM

PURPOSE: To document BPA's equivalencies for DOE Order DOE O-541.1B, *Appointment of Contracting Officer and Contracting Officer Representatives.*

BACKGROUND: BPA has traditionally followed DOE Order 541.18 although is excluded from the order in section $3c^1$. In addition, BPA has equivalent requirements to section 4 of the order. This memo documents the rationale for this exclusion and describes the equivalencies that exist to assure that BPA is following all applicable laws and regulations.

JUSTIFICATION: BPA is granted independent contracting authority pursuant to the Bonneville Project Act of 1937 (16 U.S.C. § 832a(f) and is exempt from the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) pursuant to the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1939. BPA's equivalency for section 4 of DOE-O-541.1 is BPA's purchasing policies, the Bonneville Purchasing Instructions (BPI) Part 2.2.1, which governs appointment of Contracting Officers and Contracting Officer Representatives. BPA requirements for appointment as a Contracting Officer or Contracting Officer Representative are set forth in Appendix 2-A of the BPI.
