SUBJECT: Request to Cancel DOE M 200.1-1 Chapter 9, Public Key Cryptography and Key Management

PURPOSE: Cancel Department of Energy (DOE) M 200.1-1 Chapter 9, Public Key Cryptography and Key Management

JUSTIFICATION: DOE M 200.1-1 Chapter 9 was put into effect in order to create a manual with guidelines for establishing and maintaining a DOE Public Key Infrastructure (PKI). This Chapter 9 defined the guidelines related to roles, requirements, and responsibilities for establishing and maintaining a DOE PKI, and the documentation necessary to ensure that all PKI certificates are managed in a manner that maintains the overall trust required to support a viable PKI infrastructure.

Except for Chapter 9, DOE M 200.1-1 was canceled by DOE M 205.1-3, *Telecommunications Security Manual*, dated 4-17-06. The intent was to revise and issue Chapter 9 as a separate document within the Cyber Security Program. However, the Federal Chief Information Officers' (CIO) Council has consolidated PKI programs into the Identity, Credential, and Access Management (ICAM) Program. PKI guidelines and requirements have now been included in DOE Order 206.2, *Identity, Credential, and Access Management*, which was approved on February 19, 2013. DOE O 206.2 states that DOE PKI certificates must be issued in compliance with current Federal PKI Policies and guidelines maintained by Federal CIO Council committees, and implemented by GSA through the Federal PKI Policy Authority. DOE has begun the process to migrate its PKI users to a Federal PKI-compliant, cloud-based Shared Service Provider model. As a result, DOE M 200.1-1 Chapter 9 is no longer required and should be cancelled.
