SUBJECT: Request to Cancel DOE G 430.1-2, Implementation Guide for Surveillance and Maintenance during Facility Transition and Disposition, DOE G 430.1-3, Deactivation Implementation Guide, and DOE G 430.1-4, Decommissioning Implementation Guide

PURPOSE: The subject Guides address scopes of work performed primarily by the Office of Environmental Management. Based on a 20 year successful history of implementing Deactivation and Decommissioning (D&D) and Surveillance and Maintenance during D&D, the Program and its contractors are fully knowledgeable and experienced in the technical implementation of these work scopes consistent with the Guides.

JUSTIFICATION: The guidance provided in these documents has been successfully integrated into the lowest levels of work practices and as such, no longer serve a driving and required technical input. Integration has occurred through the actual implementation of D&D projects since the issuance of the Guides and can be observed through reviews of planning documents (most significantly DOE O 413 Critical Decision documents) and execution of projects. As the suite of Guides proposed for cancellation are not requirements, this integration has not been a formal documented process, but rather a continuous improvement practice and the application of lessons learned developed through project planning and execution. The proposed cancellation and justification has been coordinated with two of EM's major sites where D&D work is being implemented.

Cancellation of the Guides will support streamlining the DOE Directives System without negatively impacting the planning or performance of D&D.

IMPACT: No organizational impacts have been indentified or are anticipated as a result of the proposed cancellation. No cost savings are associated with the proposed cancellation.
