**ISSUE:** Whether to cancel DOE O 350.5, *COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors*.

**BACKGROUND:** The President issued an executive order on May 9, 2023, "Moving Beyond COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements for Federal Workers," that revoked Executive Order 14042, "Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors." Because the purpose of DOE O 350.5 was to implement the now revoked Executive Order 14042, DOE O 350.5 is being cancelled.
